Edgar Jenkins, a barrister, was the first training officer of the Ministry of National Insurance on its foundation. He subsequently instituted the valuable and impeccably prepared series of tribunal reports which he continued to edit for some years after his official retirement.

So long as he was on the Committee of the Association he ensured that due regard was paid to the law of national insurance. On his departure he left a gap no one could be found to fill.

He followed the principles he believed in to the extent of not having a bank account as he disapproved of banks, and had an encyclopaedic knowledge both of his subject and of many others. Above all he radiated benevolence. He will be greatly missed.
